Simple random sampling techniques will be used for the purpose of data collection.


#### Data analysis/statistical tools to be used

# Graphical Representation And Analysis Of Questionnaires


#### Respondents


Q.1.How do you attend class?







## Q.3. Do you attend the full duration of all classes?





# Q.While attending online class are you able to understand concepts to the full extent?






Q.6. Out of these, which one do you prefer?


that 64% of students liked offline exams and about 36% liked online exams.

## Q.7. Attending online classes is stressful?





# Q.8. Are you feeling any of the following symptoms?





# Q.9. Are online classes affecting your sleep?





# Q.10. How active are you?






Q.11. Are you able to develop your personality through online classes?


# Q.12. How would you rate ease of understanding the subjects in online classes?







# Q.13. How would rate the ease of communicating with the professor through online classes?





Q.14. how would you rate the ease of making friends through online classes?




