गुणवत्ता की दृष्टि से तो स्थिति और भी खराब है एक ओर हम सभी के लिए शिक्षा का अभियान चला रहे है तो दूसरी तरफ लाखों बच्चों को केवल अक्षर ज्ञान करा देने की धोखा धड़ी कर रहे हैं और राष्ट्र की भावी पीढ़ी के भविष्य को अन्धकारमय बना रहे हैं। उच्च शिक्षा की स्थिति भी कुछ इससे अच्छी नहीं है। आखिर कब तक ऐसा चलेगा? आखिर कब तक हम भारत के पढ़े लिखे कहे जाने वाले प्रबुद्ध नागरिक भी अपनी ओर से कोई अपनी पहल न करके सरकार की तरफ निहारते रहेंगे।

हम यह उम्मीद करते हैं कि आप अपने नये तार्किक विचारों को हमारे शोध प्रकाशन में प्रकाशित करते हुए शिक्षा की गुणवत्ता को बनाए रखने वाले इस यज्ञ में अपना अमूल्य योगदान देते रहेंगे।
